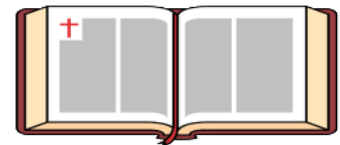
Invites you to experience Jesus' passion by visiting several different interactive stations that encourage participants to meditate on Jesus' death for them and what that means in their daily lives.

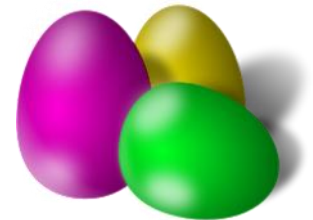
5 Loaves Food Bank Donation Calendar
