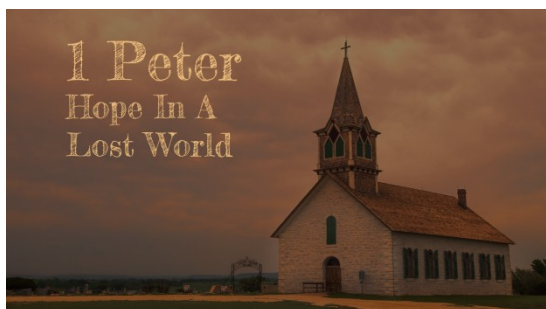

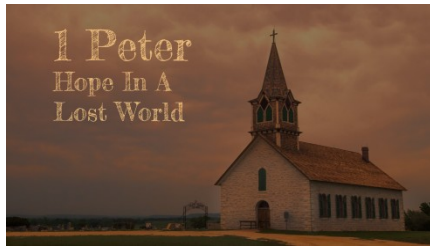


# 1 Peter

# Read 1 Peter

## Chapter 4

- ▶ In verses 1-3 Peter comes back to Christ willing to suffer, and our desire should be the same. How can we put the old life aside and be ready to suffer?

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- ▶ In verses 3-6 Peter writes about a common problem and that is peer pressure. How can our old friends or lives make an impact on where we have been, and yet Christ make an impact on where we are going?

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- ▶ In verses 7-9 Peter speaks of an end to the world. How should our lives reflect the news of this impending doom?

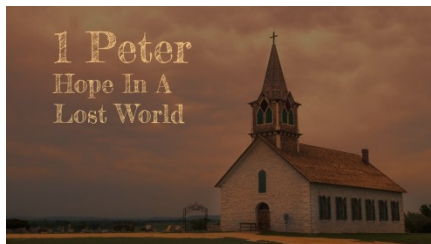
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# Read 1 Peter

## Chapter 4

- ▶ In verses 10-11 Peter speaks of using our gifts wisely. How can we find our gifts and use them to further the kingdom of God through Christ? Also reference Romans 12: 6-8

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- ▶ In verses 12-13 Peter again speaks of suffering and trials. How can we possibly be “glad” in the middle of our suffering?

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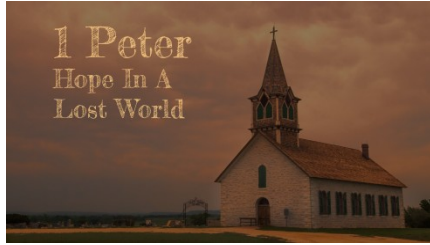
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# Read 1 Peter

## Chapter 4

- ▶ In verses 13-17, Peter speaks again to the heart of doing right in the face of adversity and persecution. How is our life supposed to look to those who do evil against us? How are we to treat our enemies?

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- ▶ In verses 14-19 Peter outlines the things that we should suffer for, and the things we should not. Why is it so important to pay attention to what we are suffering for? Could it be our own choices? (*1 Peter 2: 20 & Proverbs 11:31*)
