- ▶ Nicodemus - John 3:1-21 ; 7:50 ; 19:38-39 - March 11th
- ▶ The Samaritan woman at the well - John 4:1-42 - March 18th
- ▶ Jesus heals the blind man - John 9 : 1-41 - March 25th
- ▶ Jesus raises Lazarus - John 11 : 1-45 - April 1st
- ▶ Saul of Tarsus - Acts 9:1-31 - April 8th
